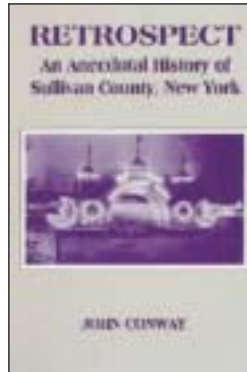

### An Anecdotal History of Sullivan County

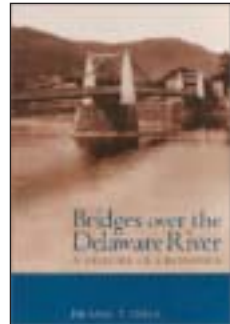

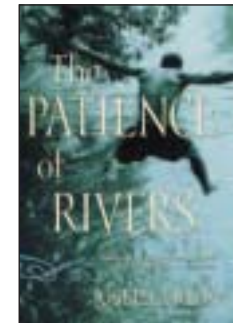
